Players' Code of Conduct

- Compete within the rules and always abide by the referee's or umpire's decision (*Note: PSSA rules may differ from weekend sport rules*)
- Attend all team training and preparation sessions and be punctual.
- Never argue with an official. If I disagree, I will have my captain or coach approach the official during a break or after the game.
- Control my temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately fouling or provoking an opponent or throwing equipment is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
- Work equally hard for myself and my team. My team's performance will benefit and so will I.
- Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good plays whether they are by my team or the other team.
- Treat all players as I would like to be treated. I will not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Co-operate with my coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- Always wear the correct uniform and bring the required equipment.
- Take responsibility for my team's equipment. Help pack up and carry the kit after training and games.
- Tell my coach if I know that I will be absent from training or a game.
